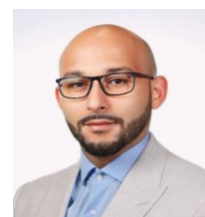

Mohammad I. M. Hojouj, Assistant Professor, MD, MSc, Oncologist, Master of medicine, is an accomplished medical oncologist, clinical researcher, and academic physician with extensive experience in oncology practice, clinical trials, and medical education. He is currently based in Dnipro (formerly Dnipropetrovsk), Ukraine, and holds Ukrainian nationality. He is married.

Dr. Hojouj obtained his Doctor of Medicine (MD) degree from Dnipro Medical University in 2012, graduating with honors and receiving a Red Diploma for outstanding academic performance. He subsequently completed a Master of Science in Oncology with honors in 2014. In 2018, he earned his PhD in Oncology from Dnipro Medical University. His doctoral research focused on the effectiveness of systemic breast cancer treatment based on body mass index, leading to a therapeutic approach that was later adopted as standard clinical practice.

He is board-certified as a Medical Oncologist in Ukraine (Chemotherapy, 2015) and holds certification in Good Clinical Practice (GCP). Dr. Hojouj has undergone advanced professional training in exploratory drug development at King's College London and in the design and interpretation of clinical trials at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.

Academically, Dr. Hojouj serves as an Associate Professor and Lecturer in Medical Oncology at Dnipro Medical University, where he is responsible for the education and training of both domestic and international medical students. He has also held the role of Assistant Professor in the Department of Oncology and Medical Radiology. His teaching philosophy emphasizes academic rigor, ethical practice, and patient-centered care.

Clinically, Dr. Hojouj has more than a decade of experience in medical oncology and has participated in over nine international clinical research studies as a sub-investigator. His research interests include early oncology drug development, chemotherapy optimization, and translational cancer research. From 2018 to 2022, he worked as a Consultant Oncologist, combining clinical duties with academic research.

In the pharmaceutical and clinical development sector, Dr. Hojouj served as a Senior Clinical Development Physician at Simbec-Orion Ltd (2022–2024), contributing to the design and execution of Phase I–III clinical trials. Since September 2024, he has held the position of Associate Medical Director. He is also an Honorary Senior Lecturer in Medical Oncology at the University of Manchester., a member of The National Comprehensive Cancer Network NCCN

Dr. Hojouj is an active member of several international professional organizations, including ASCO, ESMO, ESGO, SITC, the British Medical Association, and the Royal College of Oncology and Radiology. He has delivered lectures and presentations at international conferences across Europe and the Middle East and continues to contribute to oncology education, research, and global clinical collaboration.
